

Accessibility Statement

The Educational Company of Ireland (Edco) is committed to supporting the needs of people with disabilities and ensuring, that its eBooks are provided in an easy and accessible manner. We recognise and respect the diverse needs of our audience, and we have an ongoing programme of delivery to support the supply of our accessible eBooks in a manner which is compliant with the European Accessibility Act and the European Union (Accessibility Requirements of Products and Services) Regulations 2023.

In order to deliver the accessible eBooks in the most straightforward and functional manner we have teamed up with Bookshare Ireland <u>www.bookshare.ie</u> who will handle the provision of the requested titles.

Edco Accessible eBooks conform to accessibility best practices as defined in **EPUB3 Accessibility Guidelines** and **WCAG 2.2 AA** standards, where applicable, and to maximise their foreseeable use by persons with disabilities. They are designed to work with assistive technologies including screen readers, refreshable braille displays, and text-to-speech engines. The Edco Accessible eBooks are discoverable through the use of information in metadata as to their accessibility features.

Edco's EPUB3 File Specification

- All our accessible EPUB3 files comply with WCAG2.2 Level AA
- All Table of Contents in our EPUB3 files are hyperlinked
- *Digital links are currently not accessible. However, Edco is working on making post 28/06/25 digital content accessible.

Bookshare Ireland's Accessibility Features

Dolphin EasyReader (Bookshare's default EPUB3 reader) Features

- As the table of contents are hyperlinked, selecting the heading in the content listing will then take you to the relevant page of the book
- TTS The text to speech will read out what is on the screen and in the correct sequencing- especially if you are looking at tables and bubble speech within the text
- You can also change the accent with text to speech slow down and speed up the TTS reader as well
- Font can be enlarged to a comfortable size on the screen, and it will allow you to change the contrast and highlight words/sentences



Alternative formats offered by Bookshare

- Users can select a BRF (Braille Ready file) format of the publication which will work with a digital Braille reader
- EPUB also will work with JAWS or NVDA
